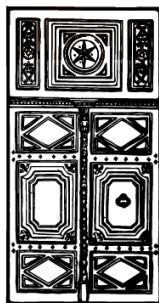

Boiserie

Boiserie is a captivating decorative art focused on enhancing paneling, from floor to cornice. It encompasses various wooden decorative elements and employs a range of techniques, including painting, carving, and inlaying.

The origins of this art form trace back to ancient Egypt, where pharaohs adorned their palaces with intricate woodwork. During the Renaissance, starting in the 16th century, woodwork began to flourish in civil architecture, initially in religious structures and later in grand castles, such as the Château de Blois around 1520. At this time, woodwork served not only a decorative purpose but also provided acoustic and thermal insulation.

Subsequently, this exquisite craft was used to embellish some of Europe's most magnificent palaces, including Versailles in France, the Château de Laeken in Belgium, Buckingham Palace in the UK, and Schönbrunn Palace in Austria.

Woodwork is not just an art, it is a highly technical and unique skill that we have been dedicated to mastering and perfecting since 1963.



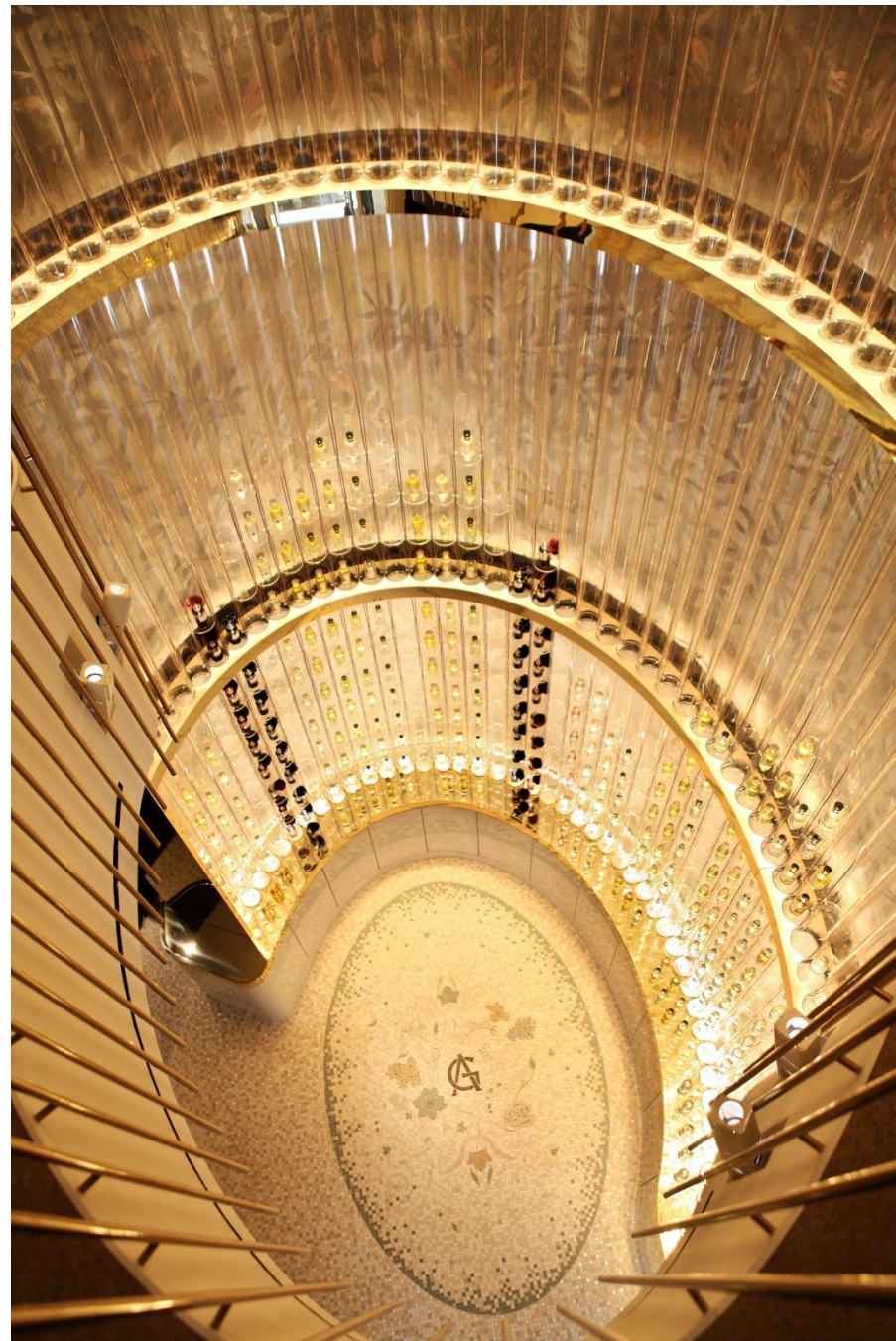
Millworks

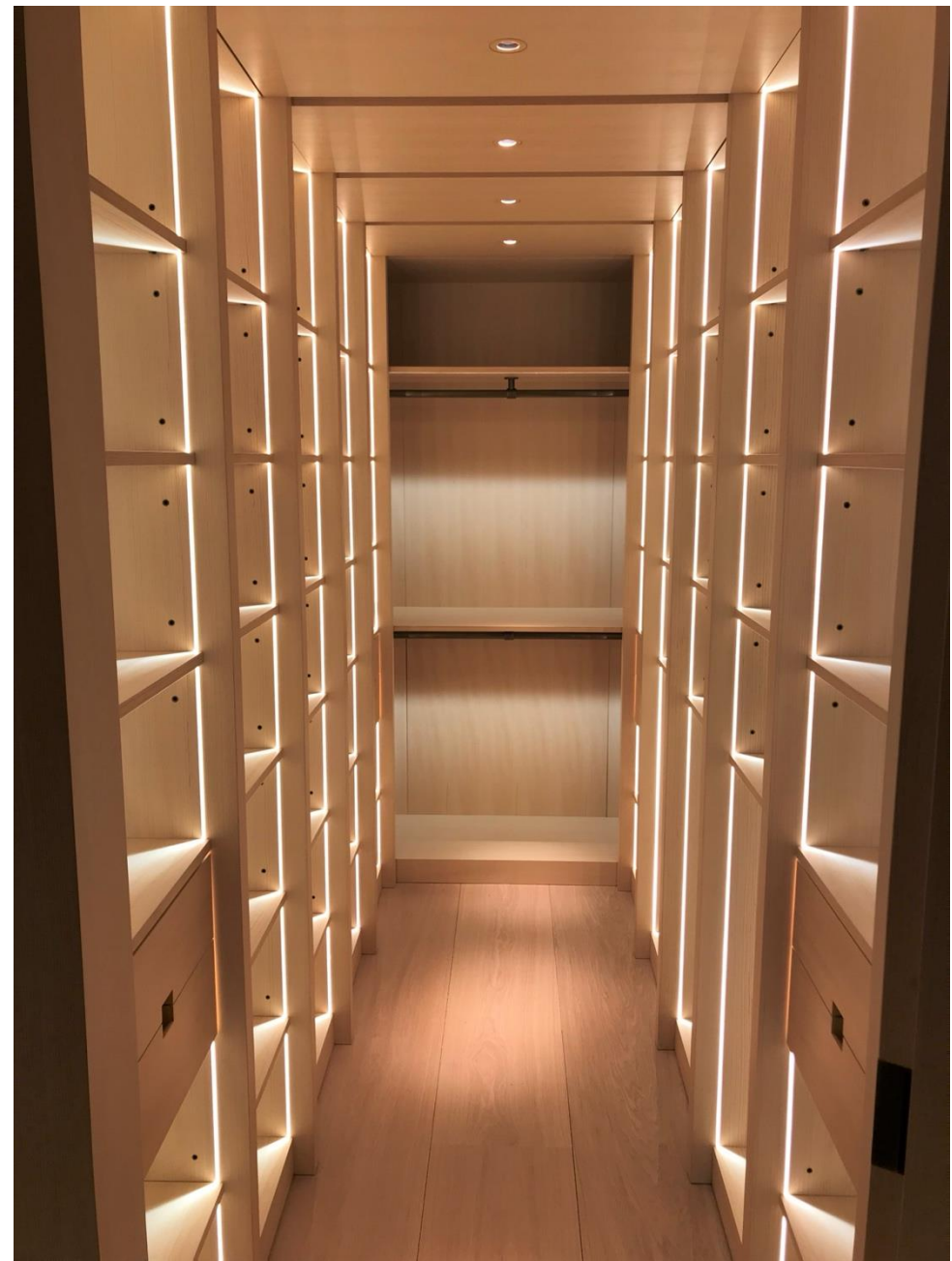

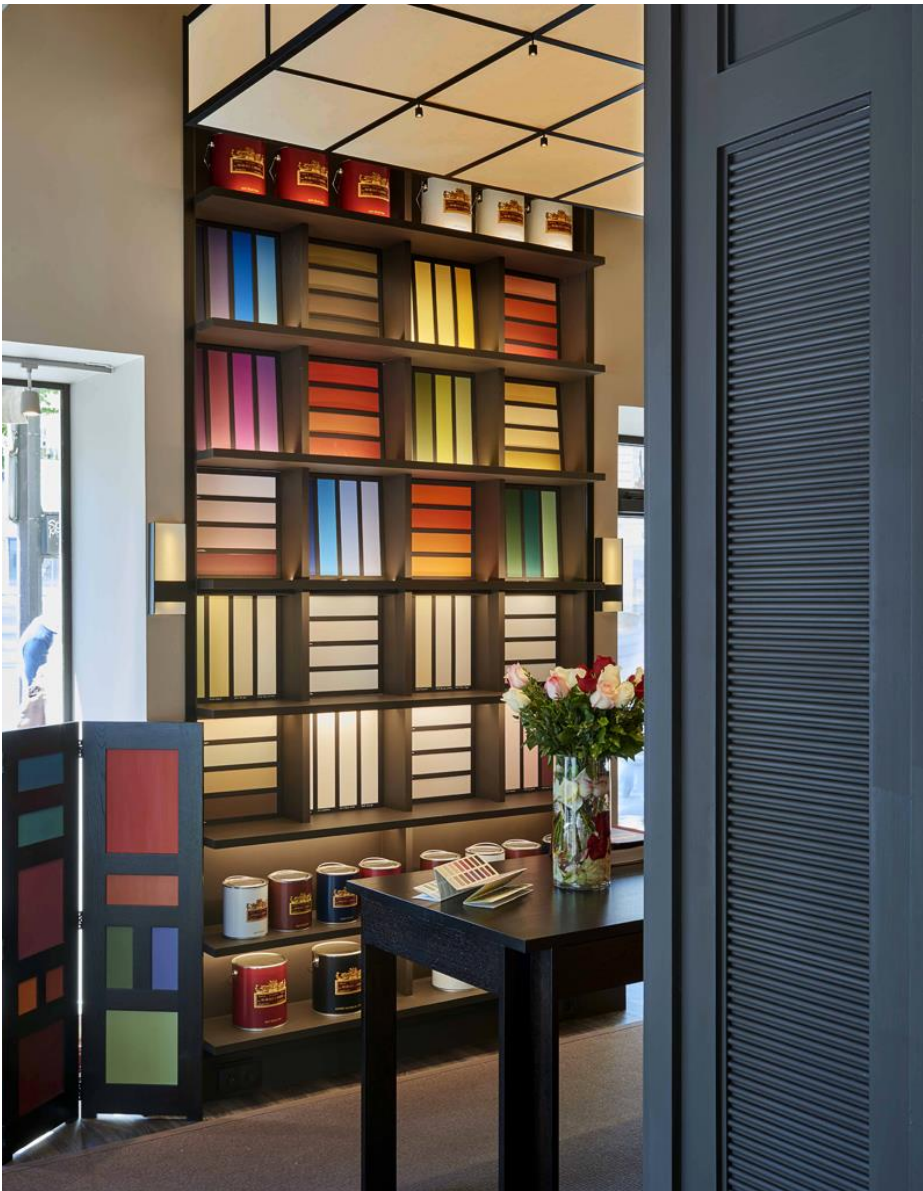
